## **RESOLUTION NO. 24-36 SUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Board Education of the San Leandro Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on September 10th at 7 o'clock, which is on or before the eighth week of school, and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board provided at least 10 days' notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing board encouraged participation by parents/guardians, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, information provided at the public hearing detailed the extent to which sufficient textbooks or other instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the San Leandro Unified School District; and

**WHEREAS**, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each student, including each English learner, has a standards-aligned textbook or instructional materials to use in class and to take home, which may include materials in a digital format but shall not include photocopied sheets from only a portion of a textbook or instruction materials copied to address a shortage, and;

**WHEREAS**, textbooks or instructional materials in core curriculum subjects should be aligned with state academic content standards and/or the Common Core State Standards adopted by the State Board of Education;

**WHEREAS**, sufficient standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks were provided to each student, including English learners, in mathematics, science, history-social science, and English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program; and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each student enrolled in world/foreign language or health classes; and

**WHEREAS**, laboratory science equipment was provided for science laboratory classes offered in grades 9-12 inclusive; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held on September 10, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. for public comment.

**THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED** by this Board that for the 2024-2025 school year, the San Leandro Unified School District has provided each student with sufficient standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum framework; and
