WHEREAS, April has been designated National Autism Acceptance month by the Autism Society of America; and

WHEREAS, Autism spectrum disorders are a group of developmental disabilities that may cause significant social, communication, and behavioral challenges across the lifespan of an individual; and

WHEREAS, National Autism Acceptance month was conceived to educate the community and celebrate opportunities associated with living, attending school, and working alongside individuals with autism spectrum disorders and their families; and

WHEREAS, Children and adolescents with autism spectrum disorders each present with a highly individualized pattern of needs and abilities; and

WHEREAS, More than 97,000 California public school students have been diagnosed as autistic; and

WHEREAS, San Leandro Unified School District currently educates approximately 290 students with autism; and

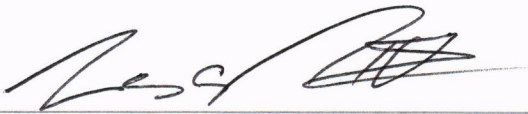

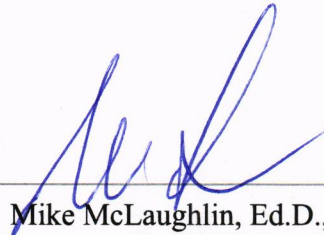
WHEREAS, San Leandro Unified School District intends, together with our partners, to ensure our students are prepared for postsecondary success in college, careers, and the community; now therefore be it
